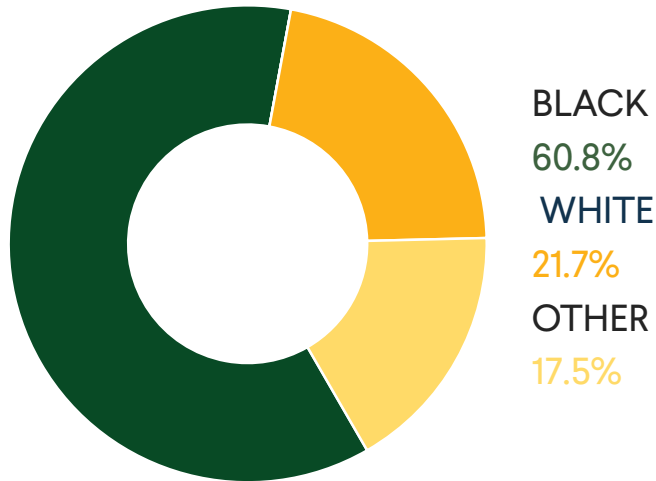

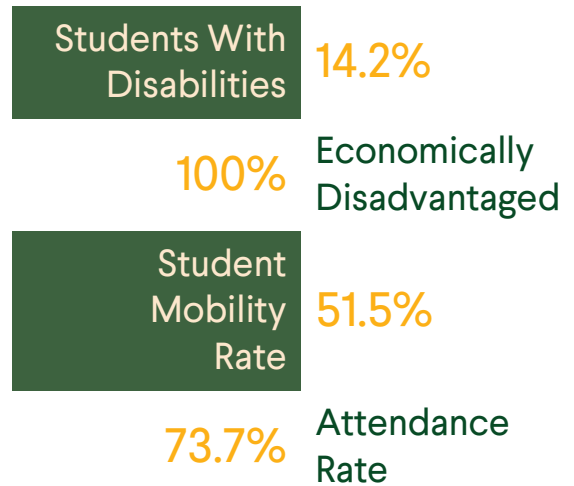


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Student Demographics

Progress towards Goals

The percent proficient in ELA on the state assessment increased from 13.4% in SY2024 to 20% in SY2025.

The percent proficient in Math on the state assessment increased from 3% in SY2024 to 26% in SY2025.

Attendance increased from SY2024 to SY2025 by three percentage points.

Our Academic Goals

- #1 By FY2028, the overall percentage of students reaching proficiency or above on state tests in English Language Arts and Mathematics will increase by 30%.
- #2 By June 2028, the performance of students will improve by increasing the attendance rate by 15%.

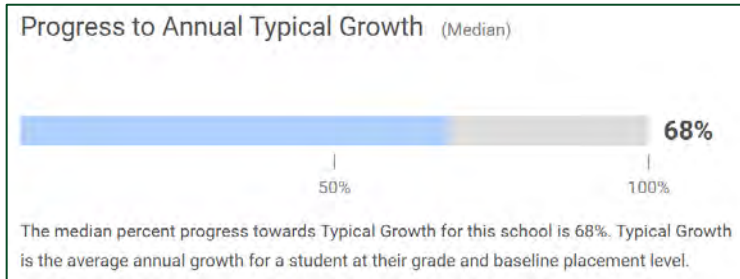

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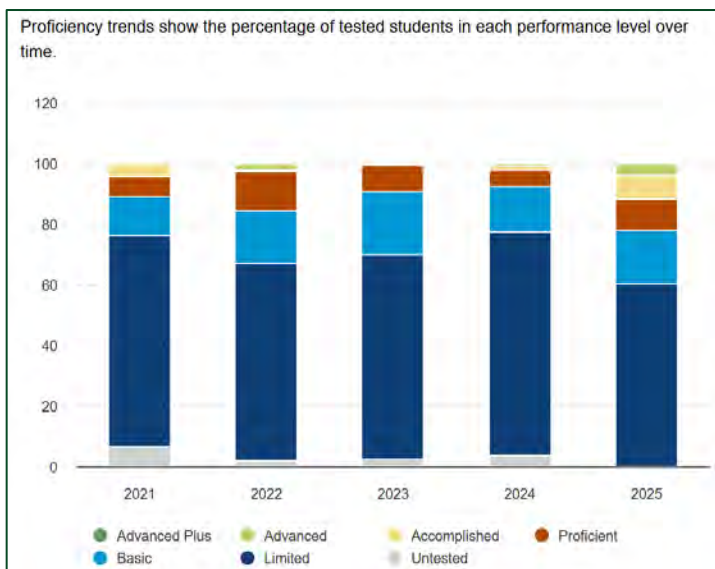
iReady Data Reading
